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- All Year 2 children across the country will be sitting end of Key Stage 1 Assessments
- The tests will be completed throughout the month of May so it will be vital that your child is in school so that they do not miss the tests
- The school will continue to gather evidence throughout June before submitting results to the Department of Education.



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What will the new tests will consist of?

English reading Paper 1: combined reading prompt and answer booklet

English reading Paper 2 : reading booklet and reading answer booklet

mathematics Paper 1 : arithmetic

mathematics Paper 2 : reasoning



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- The tests will be used to inform the overall teacher assessment and parents will be informed about whether their child is working below, broadly in line, at or above the expected standard.
- Teachers will be using the Teacher Assessment Framework to support their judgements (a copy is provided for you). These statements will be used to assess all pupils in line with the guidance given by the Department of Education.
- Higher attaining children may be working above the expected standard (Greater Depth Standard) whereas lower attaining children may be working towards the expected standard.



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- Mr Dourado, Mrs Ravji, Miss Gollins will be overseeing the tests throughout the month of May
- The tests will be done in the classroom or in small groups.
- We will follow the guidance given by the Department of Education. Breaks will be given to children or the test will be completed in chunks if necessary



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- Supporting your child at home:
- Daily reading with your child (asking questions to improve reading comprehension)
- Homework will be linked to learning in class with a particular focus in English on grammar (however there will be other homework choices across the curriculum)
- We have purchased some books specifically to support English grammar and maths. These books normally retail at £4.95 in shops such as WH Smith. If you would like these books we would be happy to provide you with these for a small donation of £2.00 per book.
