Sports Premium

Report to Governors and Parents: 2014- 2015

The government provided additional funding of £150 million per annum for academic years 2013 to 2014 and 2014 to 2015 to improve provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools. This funding - provided jointly by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport was allocated to primary school headteachers.

This funding was ring-fenced and therefore could only be spent on provision of PE and sport in schools

Funding for schools was calculated by reference to the number of primary-aged pupils (between the ages of 5 and 11), as recorded in the annual schools census in January 2014.

In 2014-15 the school was allocated £83690.

Expenditure during 2014- 2015

The funding received from Sports Premium was allocated in the following ways:

- To continue to be part of the Watford and Hertsmere School Sports Partnership. This has provided the school with a wide range of support including:
 - Specialist Coaching for teachers in all year groups
 - Gymnastics Club (Autumn and Summer Term)
 - Intra –School competitions - gymnastics, dance and multi sports
 - Playground games in Year 2 (Summer 2)
- To continue to provide lunchtime playground activities including cricket, multi sports and football

Outcomes of this funding

The children have benefited from excellent coaching during their P.E. lessons and also in Gymnastics Club. It is hoped that this funding will continue to allow more children to access sporting activities which will ignite their interest in sport in future years.
