Risks come from:

- **Content**-being exposed to illegal, inappropriate or harmful material. For example, sexual, racist, violent, unreliable content
- **Contact**-being subjected to harmful online interaction with other users. Cyberbullying and grooming
- **Conduct**-personal online behaviour that increases the likelihood of, or causes, harm. The digital footprint/ digital tattoo

Safe search settings can also be activated on **Google** and other search engines, as well as **YouTube**.

Advice to share with your child

- Tell an adult (parent at home or teacher if at school) if someone, or something, upsets or worries them online.
- Switch the screen off, close the laptop, exit the website, or turn the iPad or phone over and put it down if they see something that makes them uncomfortable
- Keep personal information safe, including their name, address, school name, phone numbers and passwords etc. Encourage the use of screen names and nicknames where possible.
- Never arrange to meet an online friend without a grownup

Think of it as STRANGER DANGER in an online world

- Internet users may not be who they say they are, people can easily lie online and that 'friends' made online are still strangers
