Arrangements from Monday 22nd June 2020

All children from Nursery to Year 2 will be in school either on Mondays and Tuesdays or on Thursdays and Fridays. The school will be closed on Wednesdays for all children apart from those who have one or more parents who are critical workers across a range of work sectors, not just health care.

The start time for Year 1 and Year 2 will change to 8.50am. Children must stay with their parents in the playground and not run around and play in either the Nursery and Reception or larger playground or the grassed area.

Nursery children will enter through the usual door with a parent at $8.50 \, a.m.$ and finish at $2.50 \, p.m.$

Reception- Puffin and Swan Class parents to use the Southsea Avenue entrance. The start time for Reception children remains at 8.55am but the finish time will be 3.00p.m.

Year 1 – Woodpecker and Heron Class parents to use the Southsea Avenue entrance. The start time for Year 1 will be 8.50 am and finish time will remain the same- 3.10pm

Woodpecker Class and Heron Class will line up on the marked class areas.

Year 2 – Owl and Kingfisher Class parents to use the Harwoods Road entrance. The start time for Year 2 will be 8.50pm and the finish time will remain the same-3.10pm

Owl Class and Kingfisher Class will line up on the marked O or KF.

The children of critical workers to use the Harwoods Road entrance. Cuckoo Class (Y1 and Y2) and Cuckoo Chicks (Nursery and Reception) will line up outside the Den facing the adventure playground at 8.55am. The lining up areas are marked with CC and a C. Cuckoo Chicks to be collected by parents from Heron Class and Cuckoo Group will be collected from the Kingfisher entrance at 3.15pm.

Children do not have to wear school uniform just cleaned washed clothes each day.

Coronavirus Test and Trace

To stop the spread of the virus we must contact NHS 111 online or NHS 111 via telephone if any one in our family or school has a high temperature, or a cough or loss/change in sense of smell or taste.

If you are requested to access testing for your child or another member of the family, it is your duty to complete the online form honestly to indicate if one or more of these symptoms are affecting the individual so that accurate NHS guidance is obtained.

If we do not do this the safety of relatives, friends and the public are being put at risk.

You will need to keep your child at home for 14 days and also isolate as a household. We also need to be informed about the results of tests.
